

A Family Affair: Music by Andreas Kneller and his Relatives

Born in Lübeck, Kneller was the younger brother of portrait painter Sir Godfrey Kneller. In 1667, he became organist of the Marktkirche in Hanover, succeeding Melchior Schildt (1592–1667).
